



The Fellowship Certification Pathway is available for fellows that have successfully completed a TACC Accredited Abdominal Transplant Surgery Fellowship Training Program since 2019. Candidates are required to be in practice for a minimum of one year and a maximum of five years. They must also have an active (non-expired) license to practice. During the in-practice period candidates should maintain a surgical log in the TAC Surgical Log format for the application process.


To add your surgical logs in the TAC format, you will need to add them in the TAC Portal.

To access the TAC portal, you will need to login through the [ASTS member portal](#) with your ASTS member portal email address.

Once logged on to the ASTS portal, you will click on “Member portal.”



Once you are in the member portal, you will click on the TAC Portal tile.



After that you will need to click the “Login” button, and it will automatically log you into the TAC Portal
