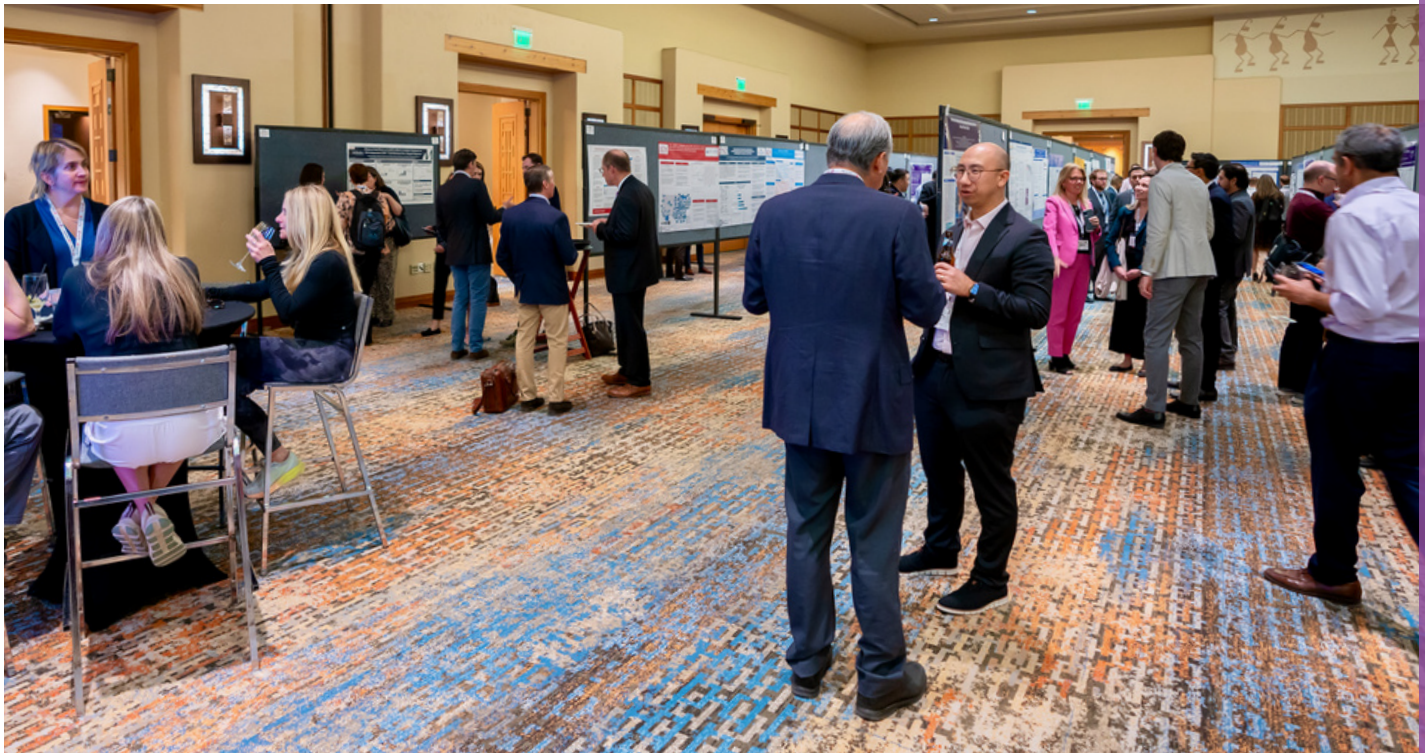




Surgeon Scientist Career Acceleration Workshop
