Transplant is at a critical crossroad. ASTS needs your support now more than ever.

ASTS members will be coming together on Capitol Hill this fall to advocate on the issues most important to transplantation:

- Support and Advise on OPTN Modernization. Advise Congress on the best policy avenues to assist the HRSA/HHS in remodeling OPTN Modernization so that our transplant system protects and improves the OPTN public private partnership enabling us to best serve our patients.
- Advance the Living Donor Protection Act (LDPA). Enlist Congress to pass the LDPA to remove disincentives to transplant by prohibiting life, disability, and long-term care insurance companies and to provide employee protection through the Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA) so workers can access FMLA to donate.
- Support Transplant Therapeutics. Educate Congress about the need to support crucial transplant therapies that improve transplant recipients quality of life and safety and prolong the life of their graft.

This in-person event will consist of a dinner & training session to provide guidance and key tips on how to advocate to legislators, followed by a day of meetings with legislative staff on Capitol Hill.
